Agnes C. Robinson, 81, of Delmar, formerly of Laurel, died peacefully at her home in Delmar on Tuesday, May 12, 2009.

She was born in Sheboygan, Wisconsin, a daughter of the late Matthew and Emma (Draeger) Jaeckels.

Agnes worked various jobs in her lifetime, but none was as important to her as raising her family. Since the early 1950's she was an active member of Christ United Methodist Church in Laurel, where she enjoyed attending many church functions and loved her church family.
