Annette Coleman Mutchler, 83, of Delmar, MD, died Monday, December 20, 2021 at Peninsula Regional Medical Center, Salisbury. She had recently fallen and was in poor health.

Annette was born July 25, 1938 in Baton Rouge, Louisiana, eldest daughter of the late Harold Bert Coleman and Helen Annette (Carter) Coleman.

Annette's family moved to Delmar, MD when she was about 15 years old. She was fond of traveling, probably 'inherited' from her father as the family lived all over the United States, with most of her 10 siblings born in different states.
