Arthur J. Adams, 87, of Greenwood DE, formerly of South Park, PA passed away after a long illness on Monday, August 31, 2015. Art was pre-deceased by his wife of 56 years, Geraldine M. (Gerry) Adams. Art was retired from his position as Executive Vice President of Pittsburgh Institute of Aeronautics where he had worked for 42 years. He was the devoted father of April Clyde (formerly Stevens) and his son-in-law Todd Clyde of Dagsboro, DE. Art is also survived by numerous cousins.
