Arthur Edward Palmer, 74, of Ocean City, Maryland, passed away on Saturday, July 23, 2016 at Delaware Hospice Center in Milford.

He was born on February 13, 1942 in Chester, Pennsylvania, a son of the late Arthur Palmer and Helen Czarnota Palmer.

Arthur attended school at St. James in Pennsylvania and later at Delmar High School from where he graduated. He served in the United States Navy from 1961 to 1965.
