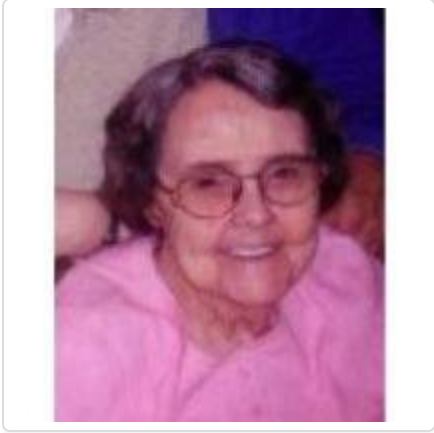




Betty Catherine Smith
