Bob Tomlinson, beloved husband, father, grandfather and great grandfather, of Bridgeville, and formerly of Davidsonville, Maryland, passed away peacefully on Friday, February 2, 2024. Bob was born August 3, 1942 in Knox City, Texas, a son of the late Roy and Eleanor Susie (Gipson) Tomlinson. Not long after graduation Bob joined the US Army and proudly served his country for 4 years. He worked in sales for most of his adult life, first in the food service industry, before retiring after many years of service as a government contractor for American Amplifier Co.
