Carroll V. Smith, 83, passed away on Thursday, May 1, 2008 at Peninsula Regional Medical Center in Salisbury.

Born in Delmar on February 24, 1925, he was a son of the late Charles V. and Lillie Cordrey Smith.

Carroll was a Navy Veteran, serving on the U.S.S. Haas Destroyer during World War II.
