Clinton K. White, Sr., age 60, of Gumboro, died Wednesday, October 10, 2007 at Peninsula Regional Medical Center in Salisbury.

He was born on July 5, 1947 in Salisbury, a son of the late William Lloyd White and Iva Worth Harrison.
