Daniel C. Williams, 90, of Mardela Springs, MD passed away Wednesday, July 16, 2014 at Coastal Hospice at the Lake in Salisbury, MD.

He was born on July 2, 1924 in Baltimore, a son of the late Daniel and Christina Williams. In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by his wife, Mary C. Williams; and a granddaughter, Shannon Einwich. Dan was also predeceased by three brothers, Bernie, Charlie and Eddie Williams and one sister, Janet Sproul.

Dan was a U.S. Army veteran, who served as a Staff Sergeant with the 726th Amphibian Tractor Battalion in the South Pacific.
