



Dennis Norman Bergeron

Dennis Norman Bergeron, 77, of Delmar, passed away peacefully on Thursday, July 6, 2023, surrounded by his loving family.

He was born February 13, 1946, in Salisbury, a son of the late Norman Guy Bergeron and Louise Marie Brittingham Bergeron.

Dennis graduated from Wi-Hi with the class of '64. Following his graduation, he secured a job at DuPont in Seaford where he retired after 37 years as a master electrician and instrument mechanic.
