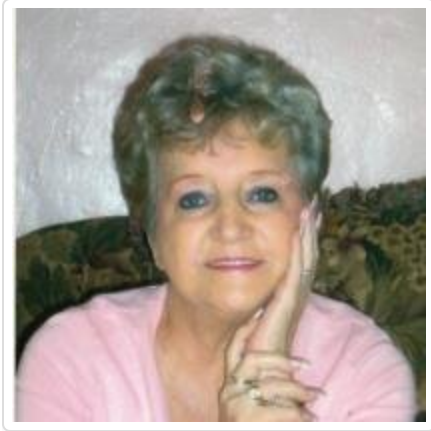




Dorothy Ann Perdue
