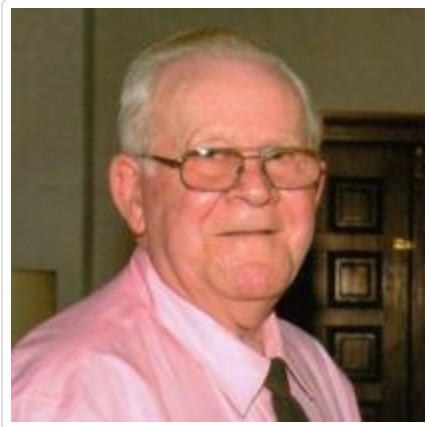




Douglas David Good
