SALISBURY-Eduardo Adrian Giorgi, 46, of Salisbury, died Friday, May 22, 2015 at Christiana Hospital in Wilmington as a result of injuries sustained in a motorcycle accident.

He was born October 14, 1968 in Buenos Aires, Argentina, a son of Teresa Garcia Giorgi and the late Normando Juan Giorgi.

Adrian earned his degree in chemical dependency counseling and took pride in helping others through difficult times. He was a faithful member of Bethany Lutheran Church in Salisbury.
