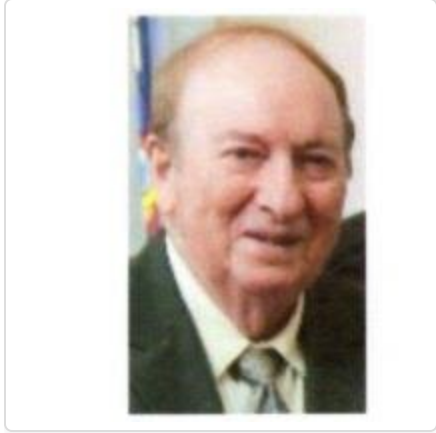




Edward Layton
