Ernest Glenn Adams, 56, of Delmar, died Friday, June 19, 2015 at his home in Delmar, surrounded by his loving family.

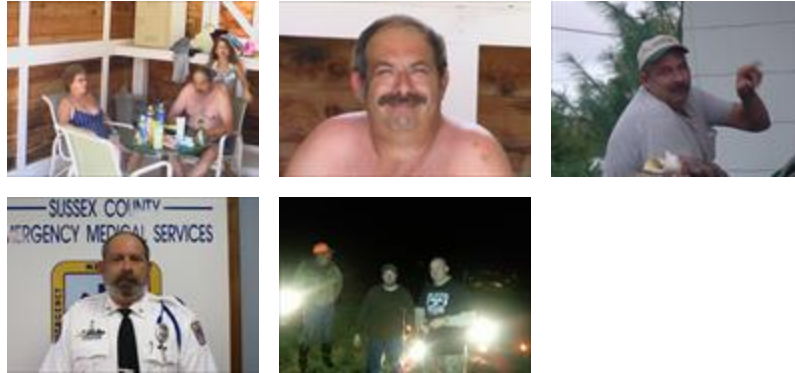
