Eudine M. Vickers, 95, of Galestown, passed away peacefully on Tuesday, May 9, 2023, at Coastal Hospice at the Lake after a brief stay.

She was born on July 20, 1927 in Tifton, Georgia, a daughter of the late George W. Montgomery and Sallie (Yawn) Montgomery.

Eudine married John E. Vickers on June 6, 1947, and together they raised their family and enjoyed over 33 years of marriage until he passed in 1980.

She retired after many years as a personnel manager for the Guida Clothing Company in Milford. After retirement, she found great joy as a caregiver for several elderly friends who she loved like her own family. She was very active in her community and served several terms as Mayor and Treasurer of Galestown, was a past member of the Sharptown Fire Department Ladies Auxiliary, an active member of the Galestown Ruritan Club and a member of Galestown United Methodist Church.
