Everett Thomas Ellis, Jr. ("Tom" "Snazzy") went home to be with the Lord on March 19, 2013, after a short illness. He passed peacefully at Coastal Hospice in Salisbury.

Born on June 16, 1945, in Delmar, Delaware, to the late Everett Thomas Ellis, Sr. and Irene Cora Cline-Ellis, he attended Delmar Elementary and later graduated from Delmar High School. Snazzy was the very first Delaware State Wrestling Champion for Delmar High School. He served his country in the US Navy, completing two tours of duty in Vietnam. Snazzy was a Laurel Police Officer and a top-notch car salesman at Price Buick-Pontiac in Salisbury. In addition, he was a diehard Baltimore Orioles and Ravens fan.
