Faye Loretta Hickman, age 83, died on October 19, 2017 at Greenfield Assisted Living of Bel Air, Maryland, after a long struggle with dementia. Faye was born on November 30, 1933, in Laurel, DE, a daughter of the late Ernest and Elsie Hickman of Delmar.

Ms. Hickman was a 1951 graduate of Delmar High School where she played sports and was involved in other school activities. Ms. Hickman retired from the Wicomico County Board of Education in 1993. 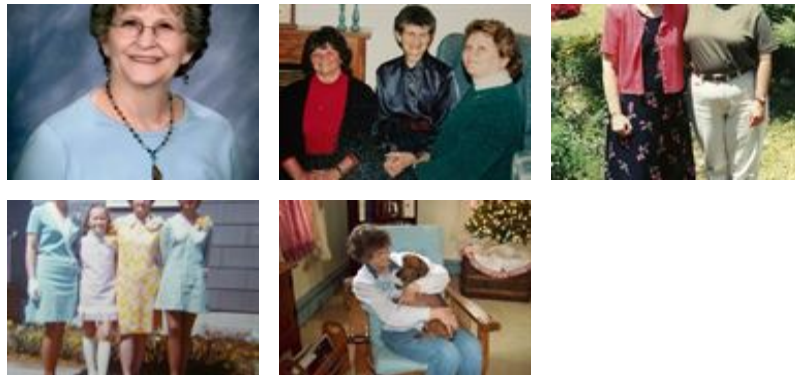
