Franklin E. Reed, 88 of Snow Hill, passed away at his home on Thursday, March 18, 2010. He was born in Hyattsville, Maryland, the son of the late Charles Thomas and Edna Grace (Soper) Reed.

Mr. Reed retired as a Medical Biological Technician, specializing in animal anatomy and electron microscopy, with the National Institutes of Health after 30 years of service.
