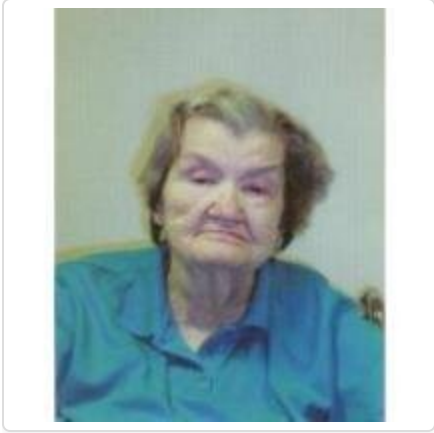




Frieda Sophie Baynard

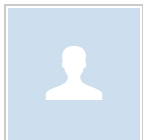
