George Harry Daly, 77, of Laurel, Delaware passed away peacefully on Monday, July 11, 2022, at his home surrounded by his family.

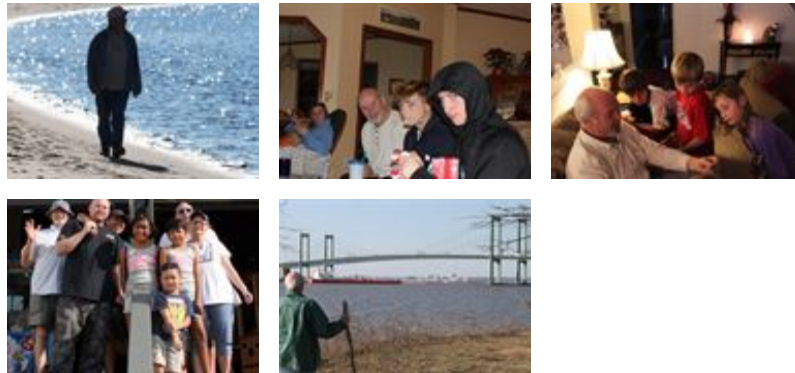
