



Harvey L. "Art" Salisbury

March 28, 1942 - December 28, 2006

Harvey "Art" Salisbury, age 64, of Salisbury, passed Thursday, December 28, 2006 at Peninsula Regional Medical Center in Salisbury.

He was born March 28, 1942 in Newville, PA, a son of the late Lloyd R. and Edna Piper Salisbury.

Art proudly served his country in the US Air Force during the Vietnam Era, and retired from the Air Force Reserves in 2002 after over 26 years of service. He also worked for Dresser-Wayne Industries from 1967 until the time of the closure in 2002. He was a long time member of the Salisbury Loyal Order of the Moose Lodge #654.
