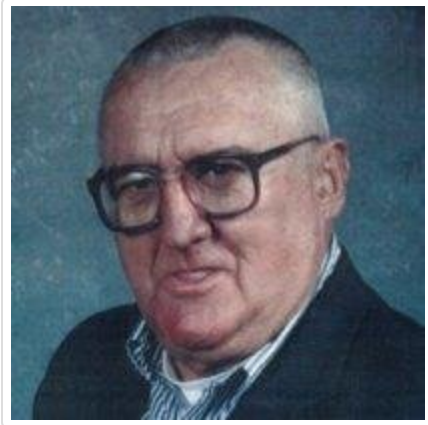




James S. Hearn "Jim"
