Jean Whelpton Jones, 95, of Springfield, Va., and formerly of Delmar, Del., passed away Friday, January 2, 2009, at INOVA Fairfax Hospital in Fairfax, Va., from congestive heart failure.

She was born on Oct. 4, 1913, in Philadelphia, the daughter of the late Joseph M. and Lula M. Whelpton.

Mrs. Jones was a retired bridal consultant from the Hecht Company in Salisbury.
