John Rodger Brummett, Sr., 73, of Laurel, formerly of Brooklyn Park, Maryland, passed away Sunday, May 19, 2019 due to injuries sustained in a boating accident.

He was born November 9, 1945 in Roderfield, West Virginia, a son of the late John Willard Brummett and Elizabeth Boothe Brummett.

Rodger graduated from Brooklyn Park High School with the class of 1963. He retired after 30 years of service as an assembler at the General Motors factory in Dundalk. In his younger days he loved living in the city where there was a sense of community and neighbors helped each other. 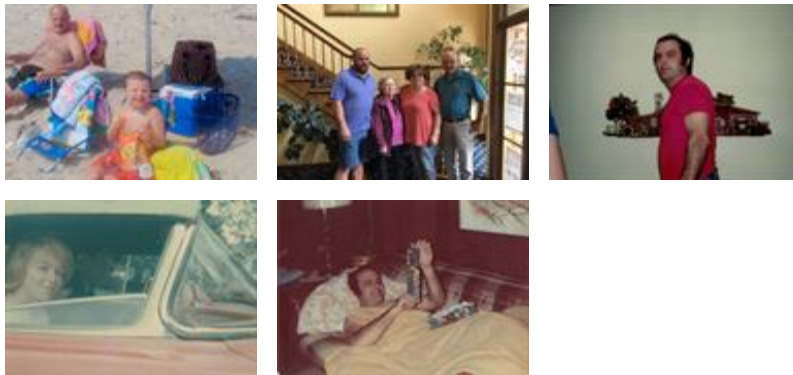
