DELMAR, MARYLAND-John Franklin Sullivan, known as Frank by everyone, 72, of Delmar, MD, passed away Monday, August 18. He was born February 27, 1962, in Salisbury to the late Raymond and Irma Sullivan.

Frank graduated from Delmar High School in 1961. After graduation, he enlisted in the National Guard and later joined the US Army.
