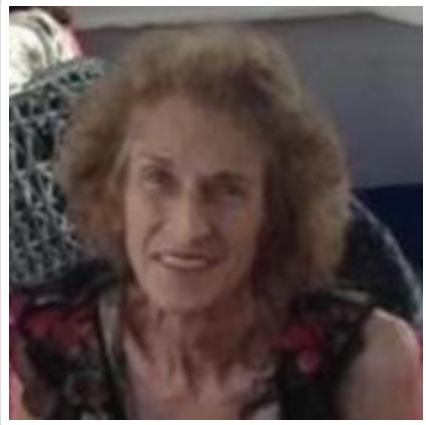




Kathryn Ellen O'Dea

Her house was the one everyone wanted to go. She loved to cook and was a great cook. She loved to entertain. Her favorite holiday was Christmas. She would have at least 2-3 Christmas trees up each year. One was always

decorated with her favorite vintage ornaments and clip on birds. She loved those vintage birds. She loved driving around looking at the different Christmas lights and displays. She shared her passion of gardening with her dad and she had a green thumb. She took pride in her garden and yard until she couldn't tend them any longer. Later in life, she enjoyed traveling and taking trips, and going to concerts and plays with Kathleen. She was able to see Cher, Rod Stewart, Cyndi Lauper, Celtic Woman, Community Players of Salisbury, and many Broadway plays to name a few. Due to Covid, she didn't get to see Celine Dion due to postponement. She loved so many and so many loved her. She will be missed by many but she wouldn't want tears shed for her. She lived life to the fullest when she could. Her smile would light up the room. Even in the final chapter of her life, she would laugh, smile and carry on with whoever was listening. 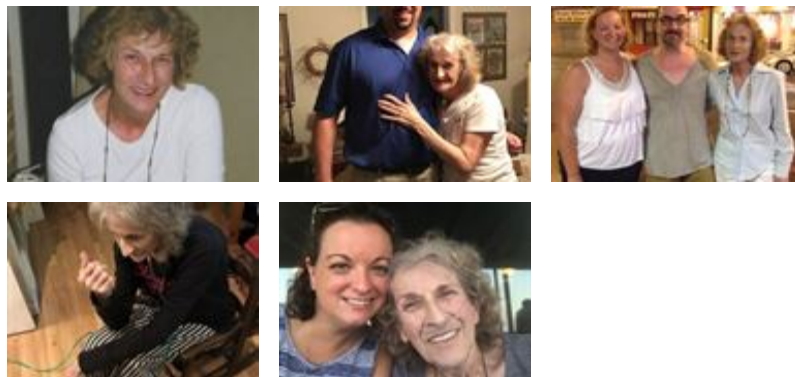
