Keith Eric Prushansky, 58, of Salisbury, passed away at his home on Saturday, May 28, 2022.

Keith was born September 18, 1963, in Silver Spring, Maryland, a son of the late Harvey and Ann Marie (Kennedy) Prushansky.

He graduated from Wicomico High School with the class of '82 and attended Salisbury University. He served in the United States Air Force. For the past 10 years he worked as a senior customer service representative for Credit Plus in Salisbury.
