Kirk E. Hall, 45, of Laurel, passed away peacefully on Wednesday, December 16, 2020 after a courageous battle with several health issues.

He was born July 19, 1975 in Seaford, a beloved son of Joyce Bromley Hall of Laurel and the late Franklin F. "Punk" Hall.

Kirk graduated from Delmar High School with the class of '93. His whole life revolved around harness racing horses and he worked as a caretaker, trainer and groomer for several stables. Most recently he worked in Bridgeville for Joshua Parker, who he considered a part of his extended family. Kirk also had a network of friends in the auction scene on Delmarva and enjoyed searching auctions for special deals. He will be remembered as a man who had love for family and his dogs.

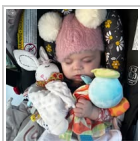
