Lisa G. Hunter passed on Monday, July 14, 2025 at home. She was married to Michael L. Hunter on October 18, 1980 who earlier passed on February 2, 2023. Together, they had one daughter, Lynda Hunter Anderson, one son in law, whom she thought of as a son, Brian Anderson, and one granddaughter, Kayla Hovatter, who was the light of her eyes, - "My Girl".

Born on October 20, 1959 to the parents of Robert C. Wheatley and Irene F. Foskey Wheatley, who both preceded her in death, Lisa lived all her life in Delmar, Maryland.
