SNOW HILL- Margaret L. Johnson Hall, 84, of Snow Hill, slipped peacefully away at home in Snow Hill on Thursday, January 19, 2017.

She was born near Marion Station on September 8, 1932 and was the daughter of the late Charlie W. Johnson (d. Mar 20, 1957) and Virgie M. Bonneville Sterling Johnson (d. Mar 7, 1985).
