Mark S. Elliott, 61, of Delmar, passed away peacefully on Easter Sunday, April 17, 2022, at Atlantic Shores Rehab and Health Center in Millsboro, surrounded by his loving family.

He was born July 14, 1960, in San Bernardino, California, a son of Kay (Rhodes) Elliott and the late Len Elliott.
