Mary Louise Heiser, age 86, of Girdletree, died Tuesday, November 27, 2007 at her home in Girdletree.

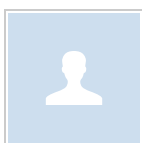

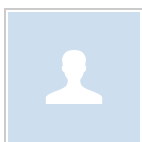
