On September 10, 2021 Myra Baker White passed away peacefully at The Mackie and Pam Stansell House Coastal Hospice at the age of 94 years. Born in Delmar, DE on July 07, 1927, Mrs. White was predeceased by her husband of fifty-six years, Kenneth L. White, her son Kevin L. White and sisters Kathleen Taylor and Caraleigh Carey. Mrs. White subsequently served All Saint's Episcopal Church as Lector and acolyte and member of the ECW.
