BERLIN- Norma Bozman Cugler, 83, of Delmar, died Thursday, October 6, 2016 at Berlin Nursing and Rehabilitation Center in Berlin after a short stay. She was born on September 28, 1933 in Dames Quarter, Maryland, a daughter of the late John and Ada (White) Bozman.

Norma graduated from Deal Island High school with the class of 1951. In 1968 she moved to Temple Hill, Maryland and enjoyed a 27 year career with the U.S. Treasury Department in Washington, D.C. Following her retirement in 1995 she returned to the Eastern Shore where she settled down in Delmar. She is also survived by several nieces and nephews.

In addition to her parents, she was preceded in death by a son, Cliff Cugler, who passed in 2005; a sister, Evelyn Long; and brothers, Howard, Glendon and Elbert.
