Pauline E. Jones of Smyrna, DE, died Saturday, July 26, 2014, at Pinnacle Rehabilitation & Health Center. Mrs. Jones was 98 years old.

Mrs. Jones was born in Smyrna on October 25, 1915. She was the daughter of the late Wilson Mannon and Emma Carey Mannon.

Mrs. Jones was a member of the St. Stephen's United Methodist Church in Delmar, DE, for many years.

She lived in Delmar for over 60 years and for twelve years lived with her daughter in Smyrna until moving to Heritage at Dover and later to Pinnacle.
