Raymond Earl White, Jr., 89, of Pittsville, died Friday, April 21, 2017 at Atlantic Shores Rehabilitation and Health Center in Millsboro.

Earl's passion was horses. He was around horse racing most of his life and worked as a groom at the Riddle Farm in Berlin. He loved helping at the fire department's bingo nights. He also enjoyed the annual trips to the pony penning in Chincoteague.

He is survived by a sister, Shirley W. Records and her husband, Richard of Pittsville; a half-brother, Raymond White and his wife, Grace of Pittsville; and several nieces and nephews.

In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by a half-sister, Lula Mae Davis.
