Delmar- Robert J. Webster, 87, of Delmar, died Tuesday, April 14, 2015 at Country Rest Home in Greenwood, where he has resided for the past few years.

He is survived by a son and daughter-in-law, Robert H. and Anita Webster of Newark, Delaware; and 3 grandchildren, Mitty Copeland and her husband, Kristofer, Emma Gilroy and her husband, John, and Alexis Cutonilli and her

husband, Kyle.

In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by his wife of 60 years, Lois Hall Webster, who passed in 2012.
