SNOW HILL- Roger Perdue Pusey, 78, of Snow Hill, and formerly of Pennsylvania, died Monday, February 7, 2011 at Atlantic General Hospital in Berlin.

He was born and raised in Snow Hill on May 12, 1932, a son of the late Fred C. and Cora Virginia Perdue Pusey.

Roger proudly served his country in the US Army. In his earlier years he owned and operated the Atlantic Filling Station in Snow Hill. His real passion was racehorses and for many years he trained and raced horses all through Maryland, Delaware and Pennsylvania.
