Shirley S. Reddish, 71, of Delmar, passed away peacefully on Tuesday, April 18, 2023, after a brief stay at Mallard Bay Nursing & Rehab in Cambridge. She was born in Talbot County, Maryland on October 19, 1951, the only child of the late Thomas Arthur Gannon and Frances Kinnamon Gannon.

After graduation Shirley earned a degree from Del-Tech. Her passion for helping others led her to a long and rewarding career as a paramedic.
