Thomas L. McCain, 71, of Delmar, passed away Monday, April 25, 2022, at TidalHealth Peninsula Regional Hospital in Salisbury, Maryland after a short battle with cancer.

He was born January 22, 1951, in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, a son of the late Marvin R. and Mary Cassidy McCain and in his youth grew up in Alabama.

Tom loved baseball and was a pitcher for the Wahouma Pony League Little League World Series team of 1963. Even in his older years he still enjoyed watching the Little League World Series and rooting for the teams from Alabama. Tom also enjoyed following college baseball and football. Tom served his country in the U.S. Army from 1969 to 1971. After his honorable discharge from the Army, he went to work in the glass business and retired from the Retail Storefront Group after 45 years as a glazer.
