



## William E. "Bo" Cooper

January 1, 1926 - July 6, 2009

William "Bo" E. Cooper, 83, of Mardela Springs, died Monday, July 6, 2009 at Wicomico Nursing Home in Salisbury.

He was born January 1, 1926 in Mardela Springs, a son of the late L. Ernest Cooper and Victoria Wilson Cooper.
